Happy New Year to Our Friends and Partners,

It's hard to believe that 2018 is in the books and 2019 is up and running. Since our last newsletter in April, we have seen the miraculous power of God move in many lives while: training up Bible students, preaching in church services, holding healing meetings, and praying for the sick. We are so thankful to all of you that prayed for us, and for those God tapped on your shoulder to sow into our ministry.

We headed to Honduras the first of May to teach for Impact University. Our assignment reached out beyond our original expectations. On our first morning, we visited the Gerizim Christian School which is part of the largest church in the country where we ministered last year. Mary and I visited every classroom of elementary-age children. They asked us questions while practicing their English.

Afterwards, we met with all the junior high and high school students for an assembly. We were introduced by Joel, one of the Impact University team members. Joel is over the school and hundreds of children in the church. He referred to us as "the one's" who prayed for him to be baptized in the Holy Spirit in 2017. If you'll remember from our newsletter from December 2017, the entire Impact University team was filled with the Holy Spirit in an upper room at our host's house on the last night. It was an experience we'll never forget.

Honduras is a rough country. It is the third most dangerous country in the world according to experts. A female gets murdered there every 16 hours. Girls are raised in fear, and self-confidence in the Lord is a rare commodity. Girls tend to lose their identity and cling to young men at an early age. Mary spoke to the entire group, but focused on the girls. She shared the love story of our daughter, Sarah, and her husband, Jeremy. She shared that it takes a strong woman to believe God for a man of God through faith and patience. I got to watch these girls as they hung on every word Mary said. It was quite impactful. We then prayed for every junior high and high school student individually. There were over a hundred. Before we were finished, there were kids kneeling and laying in the floor weeping and praising God. It was a beautiful picture, and we believe there were lasting results in the prayers we prayed over these students.

Afterwards, we went to the home of Pastor Roberto. His home, along with several other staff members, is located within a 15-acre compound that houses the church and school. It is fenced, barb-wired, razor-wired, and guarded.

Pastor Roberto is in his early 70's and has authority over hundreds of churches in Honduras and Central America. We prayed for his healing from diabetes last year, and he hadn't had any symptoms since. He had, however, recently suffered a heart attack. During his recovery, he began having dreams about his first wife, who had gone home to be with the Lord a few years ago. In those dreams, she was enticing him to come on to heaven to join her. We were told this before our visit with him and knew immediately, IT WAS NOT GOD. You have to judge dreams, not by your feelings, but by the Word of God. This was contrary to the truth of God's Word, and we knew it. So, Pastor Roberto was longing to go home and a spirit of depression had shown itself.

When we entered the house, there was clearly a spirit of death operating. Pastor Roberto and his wife were gracious as always. We were not there to judge as we've all encountered hardships along the way, but we were there to take authority over what the enemy was trying to do. Pastor Roberto was almost totally recovered from his heart attack, but was in fear that the diabetes would soon kill him even though he had no symptoms. As conversation continued, he handed us a letter thanking us for our missionary work to the nations and Honduras in particular. We asked if we could pray for him as we were joined by another associate Pastor who hosts the Christian TV program we were on last year. The Holy Ghost came upon all of us in a mighty way, and we began to prophesy over Pastor Roberto. The Lord told him that his time was not through. He still had much to do training young ministers. He was to get his pen ready because he was to write down all that God had given him over decades of ministry. The spirit of depression and death broke in that place, and joy filled the room. Mission accomplished.

Just a few weeks ago I saw a Facebook post where Pastor Roberto was again ministering in another country to young ministers. God is faithful.

That afternoon, Mary and I were invited to give Mary's healing testimony on a national radio station. Over a million people listen to this program every week. Mary gave her testimony powerfully, and calls to the station overloaded the system. We answered questions and prayed for many people over the airwaves. It was a great time, and we believe many people received the Word of God.

That night, we ministered in a new campus for Impact University beginning our series on the Life of Christ. It was a great start to our trip. The next night we continued the series at another campus for 3 hours to a packed building.

The next day, Saturday, we taught 5 hours in the heat of the day from 1:00-6:00 in the afternoon. The students were so hungry for the Word. I was so inspired to watch the students in uncomfortable surroundings never budge all day and fill their notepads with revelation from God's Word. Instead of getting tired, they were eager for more. They became more and more excited the further we got into the lessons. By the end of the sessions, excitement had filled the room. And where there is excitement, there is Faith!

After our return from Honduras, we had the honor to speak in over half a dozen different churches during the rest of the year including teaching healing classes for the month of October at our home church in Branson. Obviously, our focus is on healing since Mary was healed of terminal cancer. It's hard to deny the power of God when it's right in front of you every day.

During the last half of 2018, we had the opportunity to pray for many people and could sense that the healing anointing had increased. We had report after report of miracles and healing: tumors and growths disappearing, pain gone, abilities increased. We are still getting reports from our ministry at a denominational church that asked us to teach on healing. Many were healed and received the Word of God and continue to apply the teaching to their current circumstances.

One outstanding healing occurred at Healing Classes at our church in October. Two sisters came from Georgia to visit their sister-in-law in Branson. One had been diagnosed with stage four lung cancer. She had come to Branson for a few days to visit and then was to return to Georgia to get a prognosis for treatment, possibly chemotherapy and/or radiation to try to extend her life. They do not attend a "Word Church" from what I understood, but the sister-in-law had sent them some CD's by our pastor, Keith Moore, on healing that they could listen to on their trip to Branson. They ended up coming to healing classes on Tuesday and Wednesday. Mary taught on Wednesday and was prompted by the Lord to pray for anyone that wanted to receive healing before we dismissed. The two sisters came forward. The sister with the cancer diagnosis made it clear she came to receive her healing.

Mary prayed, and it was evident she received her healing. What was the evidence? Joy! They were so excited! As we watched them walk to their car, they were full of joy. We knew she had received her healing.

They returned to Georgia, and she met with her doctors. New tests were run to determine what protocol of treatment would be appropriate. After the test results came in, the doctors were amazed. The cancer was gone. The mountain had disintegrated into the sea. She was sent home because the doctors had nothing to treat. Glory to God!!!!

2018 was a great year, but we are excited for what God has in store for 2019. We are currently preparing for our return trip to Spain in March for XploreNations Bible College. We will be teaching on The Christian Family. We are also very excited and honored that we have been asked to teach at a new campus for XploreNations in New Zealand in August on the same subject.

She gave her complete healing testimony, and it is highly recommended if you are dealing with sickness and symptoms.
